ADMISSION CRITERIA

- CINR accepts clients 18 years of age and older.
- MaineCare clients accepted; please contact us to discuss other forms of insurance coverage.
- Client must have a documented brain injury secondary to trauma, stroke, or disease.
- Client should be independent with transfers.
- It is recommended that the client be three (3) months post injury and have previously received some type of rehabilitative therapy.
- CINR is able to address mild to moderate levels of anger, anxiety, and depression often present with brain injury; please contact us for more information.
