OUR SERVICES

AMHC provides 24/7 crisis services in the home, community setting, and by telehealth. Crisis services include a mental health and/or substance use assessment and safety planning. Referrals are provided for additional assistance as needed.

Maine Crisis Line

Connects to mobile crisis intervention 24/7, 365: call, text, or chat 1-888-568-1112 or 988.

Mobile Crisis Response

Individuals meet with providers in their home or other community setting to establish a safety plan and provide appropriate interventions.

Crisis Stabilization

For those in need of ongoing crisis support, crisis stabilization services can be offered for up to 60 days after an initial assessment.

Crisis Stabilization Units

Voluntary, short-term residential settings for adults in Presque Isle and Calais; and children in Fort Fairfield and Calais.

Critical Incident Stress Debriefing

Support for individuals or groups who have been exposed to a traumatic event.
