OUR SERVICES

Mental Health Outpatient

Available in Fort Kent, Madawaska, Caribou, Presque Isle, Houlton, Calais, Machias, and Ellsworth, offering:

- Individual/Group Treatment
- Couples/Family Therapy
- Medication Management
- Employee Assistance Program (EAP)
- Student Assistance Program (SAP)

Psychological Testing

Provided in schools or AMHC outpatient offices, with services for veterans available at the VA in Caribou.

Behavioral Health Home (BHH)

Holistic case management for adults and children with behavioral, physical, and emotional needs, available at various locations.

Home & Community Treatment (HCT)

In-home clinical service for youth and their families to manage mental health symptoms.

Community Integration

Case management offers skill and resource-based interventions for independent living, provided at home, community, or outpatient offices.

Adult & Children Residential

24/7 staffed facilities providing structured treatment for behavioral health challenges.

County Ride

Transportation support for adults 18+ with serious mental illness in Aroostook County, under Section 17 eligibility.

Supportive Housing

Stable, affordable housing in Aroostook County through subsidized programs.

Mental Health Support Centers

Harvest Inn and Valley Mental Health Support Centers assist anyone with self-identified mental health or co-occurring substance use challenges.
